



Friendship Notes

Provide children with paper (e.g., plain paper, colored paper, construction paper, or notecards) that they can use to write notes to their friends. Encourage children to think about what makes their friend special and write it in a note for them.

More Support: Take dictation for younger children and then they could draw a picture.

Encourage Children's Writing

“You and (Child) were really having fun in blocks today. Would you like to write her a note? What would you like to tell her?”

“We have a few minutes before lunchtime, here is some paper to write a note to a friend. Maybe you want to tell them, ‘I like your smile.’ or ‘I like when you help me.’ You can write whatever kind words you’d like.”
