

## I'm Thinking Of...

Think of a word and provide clues to help children guess the word. Prompt children who know it to raise their hand and then, when most child know it, shout out the word altogether.

When providing clues, always describe the *category* of the word, as well as defining features. You can give more clues as needed until children guess successfully (including initial sounds).

More Support: (choose something visible) "I am thinking of a vehicle. It has two wheels, makes a lot of noise, and we read about it today when we read about Ralph riding a... Yes! You guessed it!"

**More Challenge**: (pick an uncommon word or positional clue) "I am thinking of a body part. You bend it in all directions. And your head sits on top of it!"
