



Story Share

Encourage children to listen to and tell stories. Draw attention to important story elements like characters, settings, big events, and the ending (consider using visual cue cards). Prompt the child to include important story elements in *their* stories. Children can tell stories from their home cultures and in whatever language they feel comfortable. Encourage other children to listen and prompt them to remember who the story is about, where the characters are, and what is happening to them.

Ask Children to Summarize or (Re)tell Information

“Who can remember what happened in (Child)’s story? Where did it take place/what was the setting?”
