

Rhyming Songs & Poems

Build rhymes into regular classroom routines.

Pairing movement with words helps to build awareness of words in sentences and the rhythm of sentences.

For example:

Walking, walking, walking, walking, Hop, hop, hop! Wiggle, wiggle, wiggle Now let's stop!

Now let's stop!

Put hands up high (wiggle hands high),
Put hands down low (wiggle hands low),
Take a bow,
It's time to go!

(Moving hands with words)
Open, shut them,
Open, shut them,
Give a little clap,
Open, shut them,
Open, shut them,
Lay them in your lap.
