



Labels Everywhere!

There are labels with letters and words everywhere in your environment. You may find environmental print on signs, logos, food packages, and media. Spend some time pointing out the print features in the learning environment. Use specific print vocabulary in your discussions to help children notice and become familiar with print.

More Support: Intentionally create an environment with lots of labels. Put labels on centers in the room, objects in the room, where to line up, during Morning Circle, etc.

Label Specific Print Features

“Your name is on your lunch box. You can see your name starts with ‘J’ (*point to letter*). ‘J’ is for Josephine.”

“Here is a sign that says ‘STOP.’ We have to wait and look both ways before crossing the street.”
