



# Label It!

Have each child pick an object in the room to identify. If they need help choosing, prompt them to pick from a specific area of the room or hold up an object for them to name. Using a post-it or tape, write the name that the child says and stick it to the object! Connect the print to the object. If children call an object by the wrong name, visually show the difference between the two objects. Encourage children to name objects in their home language and use the internet to confirm accuracy.

**More Support:** Move throughout the room and label items in the children's daily routine. Follow their lead.

## Repeat Words Often

Encourage children to label items around the room they may not frequently notice (e.g., windowsill, knob, printer). Then repeat the new word often while you're labeling and discussing, and throughout the rest of the day when you notice and draw attention to the post-it.
