Name, write, show, or draw three different objects.

Two of the objects should be similar in some way and one should be different. Encourage children to help you figure out which one does not belong with the others and explain why. Prompt children to name something that fits better.

Encourage children to share words from their home language.

Draw Attention to Word Relations

“We drew a shirt, jacket, and apple. Which one doesn’t belong? Why do you think it doesn’t belong?”

“I have a truck, a doll, and a car. Which two go together? What makes you think those two go together?”
