## Counting Fingerplays \& Songs

Songs and fingerplays are a great way to support children's fine motor skills, including those that involve counting up/down from 1-5 or 10. Act out the motions and show the number of fingers as you sing (e.g., 4 fingers when saying 4). Count down with your fingers until you get to 0 monkeys, bees, or frogs.

## For example:

5 little seashells, lying on the shore. Swish went the waves. Then there were... 4.

Here is a beehive. Where are the bees? (hold up fist) Hidden away where nobody sees.
Watch and you'll see them come out of the hive, One, two, three, four, five! Buzzzzzzzz... All fly away!

5 little speckled frogs, Sat on a speckled log, Eating the most delicious bugs. Yum! Yum! One jumped into the pool, Where it was nice a cool, Now there are 4 green speckled frogs.
