



Dance Party

Explain that you will be working together to create a new dance! As the children work together on which move should come next, help them find solutions to any problems that may arise. Ask a child to suggest a dance move (e.g., a clap). Practice the move together, then encourage someone to add on. Put the first two moves together and continue until the class has a sequence of 3 or 4 dance moves. Have a dance party using the sequence of moves – add music when the class is ready! Be mindful of music volume for sensitive listeners and consider if the dance sequence is inclusive of childrens' mobility needs .
