Partner Tasks

Assign pairs of children classroom tasks to complete together. Narrate their problem solving when problems arise.

For example:

- Carry a bucket outside together.
- Wash and dry a table.
- One child picks up toys and hands to the other to put in the bucket.
- Walk down the hall holding hands or arms.
- Hold a basket and walk while the other child passes things out to others.

More Support: Encourage children to complete tasks or play near each other and describe their interactions. Narrate problems and solutions as they arise.

Reflect the Problem

"You seem angry. You can't fit your hand on the handle because their hand is there. How can we move your hands so you can both fit?"
