

This game is adapted from the Simon Says game. Prompt children to do an action (e.g., "Show me your nose!") and model touching your nose at the same time. Repeat with different body parts. Next, give children an action to do without modeling for them. Start simple with onestep directions. To add challenge, build up to two-step directions (e.g., "First touch your nose, then touch your elbow!"), with and without modeling.

More Support: Prompt children to do an action and after modeling it on yourself, gently model it on the child. "Here's your nose!"
