



Where's the Beanbag?

Using music or without, explore position words with a beanbag (or any small object). Sing or call out commands for children to put the beanbag in different positions. Make sure to model and describe the position of your own beanbag.

For example:

- ◆ On top of your head
- ◆ Behind you
- ◆ Next to your ear
- ◆ Under your shoe

More Support: Let children explore the bean bags freely. Draw their attention to where the bean bags or where they are holding them by labeling their positions.

Prompt Children to Identify Position in Space

“Where is the bag?”

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For nonverbal children, describe and prompt:

“I see you put it on top of your head! That’s so silly! Is it on your head?”
