



# Tall Towers

Use different objects (e.g., blocks, empty containers, rocks, etc.) to create towers or buildings. See how tall the children can make their tower. As they build, use measurement words such as taller, shorter, longer, etc.

## Use Measurement Words

“When you turned the containers over and put them one on top of the other, you made a tall tower. Can we make it even taller?”

“Ah, (Child) wants to try to use that block because it is longer than the others. Let’s see if it works!”

“I made a short tower. It is only 2 blocks high. Yours is much taller.”
