

Sticky Strips

Stick strips of tape or contact paper to the wall with the sticky side facing out. Invite children to explore the sticky surface. Offer objects, such as toy animals or figurines, and allow children to explore what sticks.

Examples of items to explore:

- Nature items
- Pom poms
- Toy figurines

- Doll's clothing
- Tape or other sticky items

More Support: If children don't like the feel of the tape, don't push them to explore. Rather, offer gloves or allow them to observe others' interactions with the tape. Model and narrate your discoveries.

Narrate Curiosity and Exploration

"You're discovering that the paper doesn't come off of the tape easily, but the farm animals do."

"I see you keep tapping the tape. You like the sticky feeling on your fingers!"
