

Stick strips of painter's tape or masking tape of different heights to the wall. Challenge children to build a block tower that is as tall as the tape.

**More Support**: Shorten the height of the tape so children build shorter towers. Or allow children to build freely and narrate the problem-solving skills involved in building. Provide support when needed.

## **Ask Open Ended Questions**

"Your tower keeps falling down. What can you do to make your tower sturdier? Can we work together to figure it out?"

"Wow! Your tower is so tall. How did you know when to stop building?"
