

Let's Solve It

Let children help you solve a problem like organizing a messy corner of the classroom or finding a missing item. Encourage children to use the problemsolving steps (listed below) and acknowledge their effort as they work to solve the problem.

Problem-Solving Steps:

- 1. What is the problem?
- 2. What is our plan?
- 3. Let's solve it!
- 4. Looking back, how did it go?

Acknowledge Effort
