

Who Am I?

Give clues about a person, animal, or thing. Specify whether it's something they can see at that moment (e.g., a class fish) or not (e.g., a lion). Encourage the children to guess and explain why they made that guess. Examples are below but consider the topics you've discussed and the children's interests when giving clues.

- "I have a long mane, I roar, and I like to eat antelope."
- "Every school day I bring you delicious food. I do not live at your house."
- "I have 4 sturdy legs and I love to hold journals." (table)

Prompt Children's Explanations

"Tell me why you guessed that. Does that animal fit all the clues? Let's think about each clue."
