Gather books that incorporate shapes. Encourage children to name shapes and their properties during informal reading times. As you read together, stop and discuss shapes and their properties throughout various pages in the book.

For example:

- ◆ I Spy with My Little Eye by Paula Vásquez
- ◆ My Very First Book of Shapes by Eric Carle
- ◆ Patterns by Emily Bolam
- ◆ Squares by Yusuke Yonezu

More Support: Call out shape names and run your finger over the outline of shapes while reading.
