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Hide and Find

Hide a known object in your learning environment. Tell the children that the object is hiding and encourage them to listen to clues in order to find it. Use language that encourages children to consider where things are in space (or position in space, spatial sense, etc.) as they search for the object.

Examples of position words:

- ◆ On top of/underneath
- ◆ Next to/beside
- ◆ In front of/behind
- ◆ Under/over

Prompt Children to Identify Positions in Space

“The item is hiding under the sink. Where should we look to find it?”

“The item is on top of something blue. Can you show me where it would be?”
