



## Shape Scavenger Hunt

Search for shapes around your learning environment – indoors or outdoors:

### Possible ways to play:

- ◆ Identify a shape and have them search for it (e.g., “Everyone find a square!”).
- ◆ Make a list of shapes and have them find and check off each one.
- ◆ Write down all of the shapes they see. Add tally marks for each spotting of the same one.
- ◆ Name a shape for them to run and stand by.

### Prompt Children to Identify Shapes and/or Their Properties

“We are looking for squares. What do we know about squares that can help us search for them in our room? How many sides do they have and how long are their sides?”
