



Simon Says: Body Parts

Play Simon Says focused on children's body parts. This will help them learn the names of their body parts in addition to encouraging careful listening. Teachers may want to begin by reviewing names of the body parts before starting the game.

Use Gestures and/or Visual Supports to Encourage Listening

“Simon Says wiggle your arms (*point to your arms*). Stop! Oh, I didn't say ‘Simon Says stop.’ Those of you still wiggling your arms, you can get your backpacks!”

“Simon Says touch your nose (*point to your nose*). Simon Says bend your knees (*point to your knees*). Wiggle your hips (*point to your hips*). Oh! I didn't say ‘Simon Says wiggle your hips!’ All of you who are still just bending your knees, you can get in line to go outside.”
